The cost of sending one or 14 images via UPS far exceeds the \$.50 per image charged. Our club was paying these additional UPS charges.

It was decided at the SCC Board Meeting of May 8th that the club would continue its membership in the Florida Camera Club Council, but would leave the responsibility of entering F3C competition to the individuals.
