F3C E-I Competition Coming Soon

The Florida Camera Club Council will hold its Digital Competition (2nd Tri-Annual) in June. You can e-mail your entries (up to 4) to our club's FCCC Representative, Jim Ickes, who will forward them to the FCCC. Entries will be received from May 28 thru June 11.

Judging will be on June 25. Recommended resolution is 1024x768, just like our club uses. Use sRGB color space and JPEG format. Be sure your name and the name of your club is in the body of the e-mail. Also include your competition class: A for Advanced Amateur and Professional or B for Beginning Amateur. There is no AA class.

Type the file names of the images in the body of the e-mail. Note that the title of each attached image **must** match the title in the body of the e-mail. You can enter up to four entries, any subject. All must be attached (**not** embedded) in one e-mail. E-mail your entries to jickes@tampabay.rr.com. Remember, your entries must get to Jim in time to meet the June 11 F3C deadline. The top 30% will get ribbons. This is a great chance to participate. The FCCC Web site can be found at www.f3c.org.
